Charles Arthur Raum of Aiken, SC died on Thursday, September 5, 2002 after a lengthy illness. He was 88.

Born in Camden, NJ on December 25, 1913, he was the son of the late Rev. A.F.T. Raum, who was the founder of Raum Chapel Church in Rock Hall, MD and Anna Millman Raum. He received his Bachelor of Engineering degree from Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, MD in 1933. Mr. Raum worked with E.I. DuPont de Nemours and Co., Construction Division, from which he retired in 1978 after 37 years as a cost and contract engineer. His career with DuPont includes stints in Wilmington, DE, Orange and Beaumont, TX, LaPlace, LA, Martinsville, VA, Camden, SC and twice at the Savannah River Site.

He was an active member of the Trinity United Methodist Church where he taught Sunday school, sang in the choir, and was a member of United Methodist Men. During his lifetime, Mr. Raum served as choir director, lay speaker, soloist, church leader, and Sunday school teacher with many churches. In recent years he served as chairman of the Administrative Board and was a delegate to the North Georgia Annual Conference from St. James United Methodist Church in Augusta, GA. The United Methodist men awarded him with an honorary life membership in their organization. He was also a soloist and music director for the Christian Science Church in Aiken.

He leaves behind a wonderful legacy with his gifts of faith, teaching, and leadership.

Mr. Raum is survived by his wife, Mary of 66 years; two daughters, Charlotte and her husband, Rev. Malone Dodson of Alpharetta, GA and Sylvia, and her husband, John Crews of Burlington, NC; one son, James and his wife, Barbara Raum of New Port Richey, FL; eight grandchildren; two nieces, and 14 great grandchildren.

A celebration service will be held at 3:00 Sunday, September 8 at Trinity United Methodist Church in Aiken, SC. Relatives and friends may call on Saturday, September 7 from 3:00 until 5:00 P.M. at Shellhouse Funeral Home in Aiken, SC.

A graveside service will be held on Wednesday, September 11, 2002 at 11:00 A.M. at Wesley Chapel Cemetery in Rock Hall, Maryland.
