Charles Dana Munsell of Martingham, St. Michaels, MD died on Sunday, December 28, 2003 at the University of Maryland Hospital in Baltimore. He was 77.

Born October 2, 1926 in Kansas City, Missouri, he was the son of the late Charles and Hazel Stephens Munsell. During World War II, he served for two years in the United States Navy. In 1951 he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Missouri and then worked as an engineer for IBM until his early retirement in 1987.

After raising their family in Indianapolis, Indiana, Charles and his wife Virginia retired to St. Michaels, MD in 1988 to sail and play golf. He was a life member and past Commodore of the Indianapolis Sailing Club, a member and past Commodore of the Cruising Sailors of St. Michaels, a member of the Harbortowne Golf Club and a member of MISGA.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Munsell is survived by two daughters, Jane Gardner and her husband Joseph of Zionsville, Indiana and Susan Plousis and her husband Drew of Roswell, Georgia; a son, Charles Munsell III and his wife Carol of Indianapolis, Indiana; and a sister Betty Lou Owen and her husband Paul of Leawood, Kansas.
