Easton: Charles E. Ball, Sr. died on Friday April 17, 2009 at his home with his family by his side. He was 78.

He was born on September 4, 1930 to the late Tilghman H. and Dorothy Watts Ball. He attended public school at Royal Oak and St. Michaels until 1947 when he joined the US Navy. He did his training at the Great Lakes until serving aboard the USS Zellars, a DD-777. He was honorably discharged in 1951. On July 21, 1951 he married the former Kathryn "Kitty" Geib and they made their home in Easton. He then began a career as a truck driver for the Coca Cola Company and worked for a number of other companies, including Elliott Brothers for 15 years. He retired in 2002.

He was a member of the Easton Church of the Brethren, VFW Post 5118 and the American Legion Post 70. He enjoyed carpentry work, farming and gardening.

In addition to his wife Kitty, Mr. Ball is survived by three children Charles "Buddy", Jr., Kenneth "Kenny" Ball and Karen Jo Olszewski; two brothers Joseph Ball and George "Peachie" Ball; four grandchildren Kristi Boyle, Chloe Ball, Matthew Ball and Trevor Ball; three great grandchildren, Jacob Boyle, Breanna Boyle and Emma Ruth Boyle. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother Richard Ball.

Services will be held at the Easton Church of the Brethren on Wed, April 22, 2009 at 11am where friends may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery.
