



## Charles E. Partridge Sr.

Charles E. Partridge Sr., of Seaford, formerly of Oxford and long serving secretary of Oxford's Town Planning Commission died on Saturday, February 7, 2004 at the Methodist Manor House in Seaford. He was 97.

Born in Philadelphia, PA on December 25, 1906, Mr. Partridge or "Chick" as he was known to all of his friends came to the eastern shore in the 1930's to run the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Easton Grading Service office, which graded the products of the many local canneries that existed on the eastern shore. World War II spelled an end to that job and he returned to Philadelphia. After retirement from Federal service, Mr. Partridge and his wife the former Miriam Meyer moved to Oxford and then to Seaford in 1990. Mrs. Partridge died in 1994.

Mr. Partridge was active in a number of local civic and religious organizations including Memorial Hospital, Easton, The Oxford Museum and the Church of the Holy Trinity.

Mr. Partridge is survived by a son, Charles E. Partridge Jr. of Baltimore; two grandchildren, Elizabeth C. Partridge of Annapolis and Amy Partridge-Barber of Cape Elizabeth, ME and two great grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at the Church of the Holy Trinity, Oxford on

Saturday, March 13, 2004 at 2:00 p.m.

Burial will be private.
