Charles Edward Wigle of Annapolis, formerly of Queenstown, MD died at the Kent & Queen Anne Hospital, Chestertown on Tuesday, March 26, 2002. He was 71.

Born May 29, 1930 in Niagra Falls, NY, he was the son of the late Ivan M. and Mary Spurrell Wigle. Following his graduation from high school in Niagra Falls, NY he enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1949 and in 1950 following his release from active duty he entered the Naval Academy Midshipman Program at Penn State University. After attending Penn State he married and later divorced Jaqueline Axelrod. While married they moved to Baltimore County and later traveled to Japan for several years for his job. In 1963 he married the former, Grace Vayo of Baltimore and they lived in Baltimore County and later moved to the Eastern Shore in the early 1980's. In 2000 they moved to Annapolis, MD.

Mr. Wigle enjoyed crabbing and sailing on the Wye River. He was a proud member of the Friendly Son's of St. Patrick.

In addition to this wife, Mr. Wigle is survived by a son, Charles E. Wigle, Jr. of Chula Vista, CA; two daughters, Teresa W. Guthrie of San Francisco, CA and Stacey J. Herndon of Sissonville, WV; a brother, James M. Wigle of Pottstown, PA; a sister, Mary Anne Vitabile of Gilbertsville, PA; five

grandchildren and a canine friend "Scooby".
