Charles Elden Carter, of Centreville, MD, died on Friday, May 30, 2008 at Johns Hopkins Hospital after a five year battle with cancer. He was 61 years old.

Chuck was born on July 2, 1946 in Homestead, PA to George Elden Carter and Edith Wulf and was a graduate of West Mifflin High School. He then entered and proudly served his country as a U.S. Marine during the Vietnam War. While attending Point Park College, Chuck worked at U.S. Steel and would meet and marry Bonnie Berardone on July 5, 1969. Upon graduation he would start his career with the Federal Government and retired in 1995. After retiring, they would reside in Florida until 2004 when he became ill and they moved back to Maryland to be close to their family.

In addition to his wife and parents, Mr. Carter is survived by a son; Justin R. Carter and his wife, Kristy, of Centreville, a brother; Butch Carter, of Jefferson Hills, PA; two sisters, Lynda Logue of Indiana, PA and Debra Hunt of West Mifflin, PA and four grandchildren, Brett, Tyler, Ashlyn, and Grant.
