



## Charles Elwood Anthony

February 11, 1918 - August 27, 2009

Charles E. Anthony of Centreville, MD died at Chestertown Nursing and Rehab, Chestertown, MD on Thursday, August 27, 2009. He was 91.

Born February 11, 1918 in Queenstown, MD, he was the son of the late Charles Norman "Chalk" and Pearl Pierson Anthony. He attended school in Queenstown, MD. He served in the U.S. Army Medic Corp in 1941 and from 1942 – 1945 he served in the U.S. Air Corp. 1945. He received the Distinguished Flying Cross and 4 Oak Leaf Cluster. On June 29, 1946 he married Oneida Walker from Centreville, MD. He was a waterman for his entire life, retiring in 2003.

He was a charter member of the Queenstown Vol. Fire Dept. and was a member of the Bay Country Moose, VFW and the American Legion.

Mr. Anthony is survived by a son, Joseph Anthony of NC; and a daughter, Gayle Jester, Church, Hill, MD., three brothers, Milton Anthony, Donald Anthony of Grasonville, Vincent Anthony of Queenstown; two sisters, Patricia Gertz, Queenstown and Delores Timms of Stevensville, MD; grandsons, Charles Jester of Church Hill and Nicholas Anthony of Delaware and two great grandchildren, Cheyanne Jester and Gage Jester, both of Church Hill, MD. In addition to his wife, he was pre-deceased by four brothers, David Anthony, Louis Anthony, Francis "Ike" Anthony and Thomas Anthony.
