Stevensville, MD: Charles Frederick Collins died Wednesday, November 1, 2006 at Anne Arundel Medical Center surrounded by his loving family. He was 70 years old.

Mr. Collins was born in Baltimore, MD on December 23, 1935, the son of the late Charles H. Collins and Agnes Pilkerton Collins. He graduated from the Baltimore Polytechnic Institute in 1954. In 1957, he married Joan Snyder. He would later attend the University of Baltimore, and begin working for American Oil in Baltimore as a lab Technician until 1960, when he joined the Baltimore City Fire Department. He worked with the fire department for 30 years until his retirement on December 7, 1990. Mr. Collins also worked for Snyder & Son as a voting machine mechanic. On April 21, 1987 he married Mary C. McNaney of Glen Burnie. She predeceased him on February 13, 1998.

Mr. Collins was a member of the Trains Collectors Association. He was a seasoned ticket holder of the D.C. and Baltimore Opera since 1950. He enjoyed collecting antiques and spending time with his family. His grandchildren were his pride and joy.

Mr. Collins is survived by his loving daughters; Cindy A. Young and her husband Roy of Finksburg, MD, Robin Adams and her husband Tim of Millersville, MD; a son, Charles F. Collins, Jr. and his wife Margaret of Severna

Park, MD; 8 grandchildren and one great-grandchild; and his loving companion Catherine Therres of Hampstead, MD and her children Glenn Therres of Stevensville, MD and Stephen Therres of Hampstead, MD, and their families.
