Charles Francis Murphy, of Easton, died at his home on Sunday, February 17, 2002. He was 79.

Born January 27, 1923 in Denton, MD, he was the son of the late William Ernest and Irene Towers Murphy. After attending public school he served in the U.S. Army from 1943 until 1951 in the 101st Airborne Division. During WW II he was in the European Theatre of Operations. After his release from active duty he returned to the Eastern Shore where he worked at a service station in Easton until 1955 when he became a truck driver for the Kent Freight Lines. In 1965 he began driving for the Preston Trucking Co. from which he medically retired in 1985.

A resident of Easton since 1953 he was a member of Talbot Post #70 American Legion and the E.E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V.F.W.

Mr. Mruphy is survived by his wife, the former Barbara E. Leverage whom he married July 23, 1955; a son, Mark Dixon Murphy of Ocean City, MD; a daughter, Maryll Nagell of Weatherford, TX; three grandchildren, Shari Manning, Michael Wharton and Teresa Doran and six great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 20, 2002 at 2:30 PM at the Presbyterian Church of Easton where friends may call one hour prior to

the service.

Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
