Millington – Charles Grindel Leight, 83, of Millington, formerly of Rock Hall, died November 11, 2006 at the home of his daughter.

Born in Baltimore, he was the son of the later Clifton R. and Florence Luken Leight.

His wife of 53 years, Katherine Brooks Leight, died in 2000.

Mr Leight was also preceded in death by a son, Herbert James Leight and a brother, James William Leight.

Mr. Leight worked for 23 years at the Glenn L. Martin Co. in Baltimore before moving to Rock hall in 1965. He then set up the purchasing department at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital where he served as Purchasing Agent and consultant until 1989.

Mr. Leight was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses in 1972 and served as an elder in the Chestertown congregation until his death. He loved teaching the Bible to others and was an avid reader of it himself. His sincere desire was for everyone to take the time to read the Bible and learn about Jehovah God and His son, Jesus Christ.

He loved his family dearly and enjoyed gardening, crabbing, and playing the snare drum. He grew up in the swing era and loved listening to Benny Goodman, the Glenn Miller Orchestra, and Lawrence Welk.

Mr. Leight is survived by a sister: Alma L. Stroms and her husband, Douglas, of Fallston; two sons: Clifton B. Leight and his wife Beth, of Georgetown, Delaware and Charles L. Leight and his wife Beverly of Chestertown; one daughter: Carol G. Alexander and her husband Jim of Millington; ten grandchildren; and five great grandsons.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. on Saturday, November 18th at the Kingdom hall of Jehovah's Witnesses, 2020 McGinnes Road, Chestertown, Maryland. Interment will be private.
