Charles G. McQuay, Jr. of St. Michaels, MD died on Thursday, October 10, 2002 at William Hill Health Care, Easton. He was 79.

Born January 15, 1923 in Bozman, he was the son of the late Charles G. and Virgie Valiant McQuay. After attending public school in Talbot County, he began a twenty-three year career in the United States Army. He was a veteran of World War II, the Korean Conflict and Vietnam. Upon his return to the Eastern Shore in 1965 he worked as an insurance adjuster for the Toensmeir Insurance Agency for many years.

He was a member of Easton Elks Lodge #1622, American Legion Post #70, E.E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V.F.W., Easton Moose Lodge #1520, and a past Commodore of the Miles River Yacht Club.

Mr. McQuay is survived by his wife, the former Mary Margaret Kurtz, to whom he was married for 47 years; a daughter, Mary Lynn Hopkins of Gulf Shores, AL; a sister, Charlotte V. Sieling of Bozman; a brother, Edwin F. McQuay and his wife Jo Ann of Bozman; a brother-in-law, Harold R. Lane of Bozman; a nephew, C. Richards McQuay of Chester and two nieces, Shelley Cutter and Mary Mason, both of St. Michaels. A sister, Nell V. Lane is deceased.

Bozman United Methodist Church.
