Charles Henry Crane, of Easton, MD formerly of Madison, N.J., died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD on Sunday, December 21, 2003. He was 70.

Born in Newark, N.J., December 15, 1933, he was the son of the late Harold Edwin and Ruth Denison Crane. After graduating from Belleville High School in 1952, he attended Dartmouth College and Ohio Wesleyan University in Delaware, OH where he received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in History in 1957.

During his business career, he was a Sales Representative for Traveler's Insurance in Newark, N.J. for 15 years, then was a Pension Consultant for Northeast Administrators in Westfield, N.J. and retired in 1995 as the East Coast Software Sales Representative for Software for Pentabs Corporation of Santa Barbara, CA.

Prior to moving to Easton, MD in May of 2002, he had lived in Madison, N.J. where he was a member, Trustee and Elder of the Madison Presbyterian Church, active in the Jaycees and a dedicated volunteer with the Boy Scouts of America from which he received the Silver Beaver Award. An accomplished woodworker, he was a volunteer with the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum in St. Michaels, MD.

Mr. Crane is survived by his wife, the former Patricia Harrison Childs whom he married in Washington D.C., July 5, 1958; a daughter, Charlotte H. Pluymers and her husband, Todd, of Branchburg, N.J.; a son, Stuart D. Crane and his wife, Michelle, of Columbus, OH; a sister, Sara E. Crane of New York City and four grandchildren.

Memorial services in Easton, MD and inurnment in New Jersey will be held at a later date.
