



## Charles Henry Underwood

Charles Henry Underwood of Grasonville, MD died Sunday, January 30, 2005 at William Hill Manor Healthcare in Easton, MD. He was 80.

Born on July 14, 1924 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Elizabeth and John Underwood. He graduated from Baltimore Polytechnic High School, class of 1942. Charles served in WWII in the Army Air Corp. Following his release from active duty, he pursued a career in engineering, working for Western Electric and then Glenn L. Martin while attending Johns Hopkins University where he received his Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering. He married Margaret F. Cassidy of Baltimore on September 25, 1948 and they made their home in Towson, MD. In 1962, he began working for N.A.S.A. Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, MD. During his career he worked on the Gemini, Apollo and Space Shuttle projects. Charles retired in 1985 and in 1993 moved to Grasonville, MD.

He was a life member of the Lutherville Volunteer Fire Company and the Johns Hopkins Alumni Club. He had a special interest in antique fire equipment and toy trains.

In addition to his wife Margaret, he is survived by his son, Charles F. Underwood and his wife, Barbara of Gettysburg, PA; a daughter Sharon M. Underwood of Stevensville, MD; three grandchildren, Lena D. Underwood of

Stevensville, MD, Pamela Pritz of Herndon, VA and Kristin Harvey of Annapolis, MD; and three great grandchildren, Natalie Pritz and Allison Pritz, both of Herndon, VA and Danielle Harvey of Annapolis, MD.

Services will be held on Thursday, February 3, 2005 at 11AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Chester, MD. Family and friends may call from 2-4PM and 6-8PM on Wednesday, February 2, 2005.
