Charles John Newcomb of Easton, MD died on Sunday, February 23, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 79.

Born July 7, 1923 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late E. Herbert and Margaret Turner Newcomb. He attended Baltimore Polytechnic Institute and began a career as a naval draftsman during World War II at Maryland Shipbuilding and Drydock. What began as a childhood hobby became his life's work when he became a professional model builder in the 1950's. His ship and airplane models are displayed in many public and private collections including the Smithsonian Institute in Washington, D.C. Locally his work can be seen at the St. Michaels Maritime Museum. Music played a great part in his life. He was a trained tenor vocalist and sang professionally in Baltimore before moving to the Eastern Shore in 1959. He was a charter member of the Chesapeake Choraliers and more recently a member of the Easton Choral Arts Society.

Mr. Newcomb is survived by his wife, the former Annette Foster, whom he married January 12, 1946; a sister, Dorothy Clark of Mountain City, TN; a sister-in-law, Florence Newcomb of Harrisburg, PA; a son, Leland Newcomb and his wife, Mary of Trappe; a daughter, Caroline Ball and her husband, Jim of Annapolis; and four grandchildren. A brother, Herbert Newcomb, Jr. of Harrisburg, PA is deceased.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, February 28, 2003 at 11:00 AM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton. Friends may call at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, on Thursday evening from 6 to 8 PM.

Burial will be at Whitemarsh Cemetery, Trappe, MD.
