Charles Joseph “Joe” Wilson died Tuesday, January 16, 2007 at Memorial Hospital at Easton.

Born in Washington, DC on December 30, 1917, he had lived in Easton, MD since 1990. He lived in Rockville, MD from 1951 to 1990. In 1940, he graduated from Catholic University with a degree in engineering. He was trained as a civilian naval architect at the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard and transferred to what was then the David Taylor Model Basin in 1946. For many years he was Head of the Trials Branch. He retired in 1975 as Head of the Design Evaluation Branch in the Ship Performance Department.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the St. Vincent DePaul Society and a frequent visitor to the Talbot County Library as a book was never too far from his hand.

Mr. Wilson is survived by his wife of 64 years, Margaret Wilson; his children, Peggy Grogan of Easton, Gail Langenus and her husband, John, of Bloomfield, CT and Kevin Wilson and his wife, Debbie, of Stevensville, MD. He is also survived by six grandchildren, Patrick Grogan, Dr. Kelly Grogan, Colin Langenus, Lt. Sean Langenus, USMC and his wife Alison, Ryan Langenus and Benjamin Wilson and one great grandchild, Matthew Grogan.

A Memorial Mass for Mr. Wilson will be celebrated on Saturday, January 20, 2007 at 10:00 AM at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Easton, MD. Friends may call on Friday evening from 6 to 8pm at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD.
