



## Charles L. Woodworth VII

Charles Louis Woodworth, VII of Ridgely, MD, formerly of Stevensville, MD died in Randolph, VT while visiting family on Thursday, June 7, 2007. He was 83.

Born on November 7, 1923 in Portsmouth, NH, he was the son of the late Charles L. and Helen A. Call Woodworth. He attended school in Lubec, Maine. He was drafted during WW II serving in the Army Air Corp and was honorably discharged as a Staff Sergeant. On May 9, 1945 he married the former Violet E. Pietrantonio of Maine. While in Lubec he was a poultry farmer for 18 years. They moved to MA where he began working as a carpenter. They later moved to Pasadena, MD and in 1980 to Stevensville, MD where he continued to work as a carpenter. He was pre-deceased by his wife on October 19, 1997.

He was a member of the VFW Post #7464 and the American Legion Post #278.

Mr. Woodworth is survived by a son, Maynard L. Woodworth and his wife, Sandra of Ridgely, MD; two brothers, Frank Woodworth of NH and Raymond Woodworth of North Yarmouth, ME; four sisters, Marjorie Holmes and Doris Doble, both of White River Junction, VT, Lois Byran of Gray, ME and Edna Bailey of Pittsboro, NC; two grandchildren, Maynard Woodworth and his wife,

Stacey and Jennifer Henry and her husband, Jake and one great grandchild, Beckett Woodworth.
