



## Charles R. Haines

Charles Robert "Bob" Haines of Wittman, MD died on Saturday, February 12, 2005 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 77.

Born August 23, 1927 in Trenton, NJ, he was one of ten children of the late Roland G. and Elta Cooper Haines. After attending Trenton High School he enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1944. He served aboard the USS Saratoga CV-3 as an aviation ordnanceman during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he returned to New Jersey and earned his GED. He was employed for thirty-two years as a lineman and later as an equipment operator for Public Service Electric and Gas in Newark, NJ, retiring in 1981.

A lifelong member of the Veterans of Foreign War, he was also a member of the American Legion and the National Rifle Association.

Mr. Haines is survived by his wife of twenty-one years, Michaelene Haines; his former wife of thirty-two years, Doris Organek; nine children, Barbara Davison, Charles Robert Haines, Jr., Beverly Burke, Dennis Haines, Leonard Haines, Scott Ruisch, Katina Meazell, Monica Klos and Donna Eggers; a sister, Mary Jane Sloat; twenty-four grandchildren and twenty-three great-grandchildren. A daughter, Cheryl Rundle, is deceased.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, March 20, 2005 from 2 to 4 PM at

the American Legion in Trenton, NJ.
