



Charles Robert O'Donnell

January 3, 1924 - February 4, 2009

Charles Robert O'Donnell of Easton, MD, formerly of Harrisonburg, VA, died on Wednesday, February 4, 2009 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 85.

Born January 3, 1924 in Harrisonburg, he was the son of the late Daniel and Pauline Orebaugh O'Donnell. After graduating from Harrisonburg High School, he attended Shepherd College in Shepherdstown, WV where he earned a BA Degree in Education and minored in History. During World War II he served in the U.S. Air Force. He then began a career in management at Allen Food's in Seaford, DE where he remained until his retirement.

He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, MD.

Mr. O'Donnell is survived by his wife, the former Janice Ramey; three children, Nancy O. Vincey and her husband Alain of Richmond, VA, Pat O. Moore and her husband Mark of Annapolis, MD, and John R. O'Donnell and his wife Carol of Queen Anne, MD; and seven grandchildren. He was predeceased by a daughter, Karen O. Smith, who died January 1, 2000, and eight brothers and sisters.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, February 7, 2009 at 11:00 AM at the Church of The Blessed Sacrament, Harrisonburg, VA, where friends may call from 10:30 to 11:00 AM.
