June 11, 1909 - July 4, 2010

Captain Charles V. Stanfield, 101, of Royal Oak passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 4, 2010 at Genesis Health Care of Easton, MD surrounded by his family.

Born on June 11, 1909, he was an only child. Captain Charlie has lived most of his life on Irish Creek Road in Royal Oak. He was a St. Michaels High School, Class of 1927 graduate and this year he received the Alumni of the Year Award. He also attended 83 consecutive alumni banquets and was the oldest living alumni. After graduating from high school, he moved to Baltimore where he worked on the street cars for four years before returning to the Eastern Shore where he has made his home. Captain Charlie worked as a waterman for more than 70 years until retiring in 1992.

He loved the water and enjoyed spending time with his family. He was a big Orioles fan and watched just about every game they played. For his 101st birthday, he was able to go to Baltimore to watch a game and had a good time. Captain Charlie also enjoyed shooting pool and playing cards.

He is survived by his children: Charles R. Stanfield (Barbara), Fred Stanfield, Mary Albright, Sarah Maxwell (Kenny), Virginia Brassart (Ron), Evelyn Matthews (Terry), Theresa Wallace (Willard), and Diane Parker (Ray); a daughter in law, Peggy Stanfield; a cousin, Sophie Tennant Coblentz (Calvin),

who is his last living relative other than his descendants; 22 grandchildren, including a special granddaughter, Suzette Riggio; 35 great-grandchildren; and 9 great-great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Anna Lambkin Stanfield; a son, Thomas Stanfield; and grandsons, Christopher Maxwell and Tony Hicks.
