Charles W. Hughlett of Denton, MD died on Saturday, November 25, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 94.

Born May 27, 1912 in Trappe, MD, he was the son of the late John Richards and Lulu Welsh Hughlett. After graduating from Trappe High School in 1929, he entered the U.S. Navy where he served on the USS Arizona during World War II and the Korean Conflict. After serving for over 23 years, he retired as Electricians Mate Senior Chief. He then went to work for the U.S. Postal Service in Easton where he remained until retiring April 23, 1976 after twenty years of service.

He was a 54 year member of the Denton Masonic Lodge, a member of Odd Fellows, and a past Exalted Ruler of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

Mr. Hughlett is survived by his wife, the former Marian Parks, whom he married March 2, 1985; a daughter, Judith McKinney and her husband James of Earville, MD; two step-children, Carolyn Boone and her husband Robert of Moreno Valley, CA, and Charles Insley and his wife Zoe of Stephens City, VA; seven grandchildren and one great-grandchild. He was predeceased by a step-son, Edgar Carroll Dreslinski, who died June 14, 1994.
