



## Charles W. Johnson, Jr.

March 24, 1951 - January 1, 2009

Charles "Charlie" William Johnson Jr. died on Thursday January 1, 2009, at his home in Boiling Spring Lakes, NC. He was 57.

Born in Easton, Maryland on March 24, 1951, he was the son of the late Charles William Johnson, Sr. and Nellie Eleanor Johnson. He was a US Army Veteran serving in Vietnam and also 15 years with the National Guard.
