Easton: Charles W. "Dick" Morgan of Easton, died on Friday, December 16, 2005 at the Talbot Hospice House. He was 88.

Born on July 17, 1917, in Baltimore, Maryland, he was the son of the late Charles W. and Lucy Shopert Morgan. After graduating from Preston High School in 1935, he served in the United States Air Force during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he began a career with Waverly Press, now known as Cadmus as a photographer and proof reader until his retirement in 1980.

His wife, the former Rosebelle Davis, whom he married January 1, 1941, died December 26, 1982.
