Charles William Reynolds, a resident of Victoria Walk on Goldsborough St. in Easton, died at his home on February 6, 2005. He was 90.

A native of Atlantic City, New Jersey, Mr. Reynolds was a retired senior career executive in the U.S. Government, having served in the Departments of Justice and Labor. He held a masters degree in accounting. He and his wife, Rita Reynolds, a Washington, D.C. sixth generation native and an accomplished artist, lived in the metropolitan area until she died. He moved to Easton in 1999 to be near his family. He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Parish.

Mr. Reynolds served in the U.S. Army in the Asia Pacific theatre in World War II, was decorated for valor and received the Purple Heart.

He enjoyed fishing, classical music, history and politics and avidly followed local, national and international events, as well as the lives and careers of his family.

Mr. Reynolds was the father of Hope Reynolds Harrington, a member of the Talbot County Council and former member and President of the Talbot County Board of Education. In addition, he is survived by his son-in-law, former Ambassador to Brazil, Anthony S. Harrington; and by grandsons Adam

Reynolds Harrington and his fiancée Leila Plassey of Washington, D.C. and Michael Addison Harrington and his wife Stefanie Schilling Harrington of West Falls Church, VA.

He will be interred with Mrs. Reynolds with military honors at Arlington National Cemetery in a private ceremony. A memorial mass will be celebrated with family and neighbors at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church.
