Charles W. Spicer of Millington, MD died on Friday, December 12, 2003 in the Chester River hospital Center, Chestertown, MD. He was 88.

Mr. Spicer was born in Middletown, DE, the son of the late Samuel and Sarah Weldon Spicer. He was a meat cutter for Acme Markets retiring in 1978 after many years of service.

Originally from Middletown, DE "Charlie" was a 48 year resident of Millington, MD.

He was a member of the Asbury United Methodist Church, Millington, MD, a member of the American Legion Post 192, and the V.F.W. Post 652, both of Millington, MD as well as the Forty & Eight, a fraternal Group of Veterans. Mr. Spicer was a Past Master of Masonic Lodge #5 in Middletown, DE and was a United States Army veteran serving in WWII. He was honored in October of 1998, as the only living original member of the Old Union Church Society.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Spicer is predeceased by his loving wife of 47 years, Frances C. Spicer.

Mr. Spicer is survived by his loving son and daughter, Charles Russell Spicer and Ann L. Spicer; sisters, Elizabeth Carey of Dover, DE, Mary Ellen Gove of Newark, DE, Esther Smith and Velma Whitlock, both of Middletown, DE and

one brother, Leland Spicer of Middletown, DE.
