



Charlotte Smith Bode

May 28, 1920 - May 12, 2021

Charlotte S. Bode, born on May 28, 1920, in Murray, KY, passed away on May 12, 2021, in Chestertown, MD.

Charlotte was the daughter of the late Dewitt Talmadge and Emma Meador Watkins. She graduated from Redford High School, Detroit, MI, in the Class of 1938. She then received her BA Degree in 1942 from Rockford College, Rockford, IL. She went on to receive her MA in 1943 and PHD in history from the University of Chicago in 1953. Charlotte taught at Iowa State College, Rockford College, and then most of her career at the University of Maryland, College Park. In 1944, she married Gayle S. Smith of Chicago, IL, and they had two children. This marriage later ended in divorce. She then married Carl Bodeof of College Park, MD.

Charlotte was a member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, MD, League of Women Voters, Prince George's County Board, State Constitution Campaign in 1968, Speakers Bureau, and the Democratic Party County Platform Committee in 1966.

Charlotte was devoted to the life of the mind and to responsible civic engagement, as well as to her family. Even at the end of her one hundred years, Charlotte could find "le mot juste" for situations both tough and tender, and was beloved for her wisdom, compassion and self-deprecating humor.

She is survived by a daughter, the Rev. Judy Smith Young of Gettysburg, PA; a son, Anthony Gordon Smith of Snohomish, WA; a stepdaughter, Carolyn Bode of Santa Monica, CA; and two grandchildren, Scott Young of Washington, DC, and Mark Young of Odenton, MD.

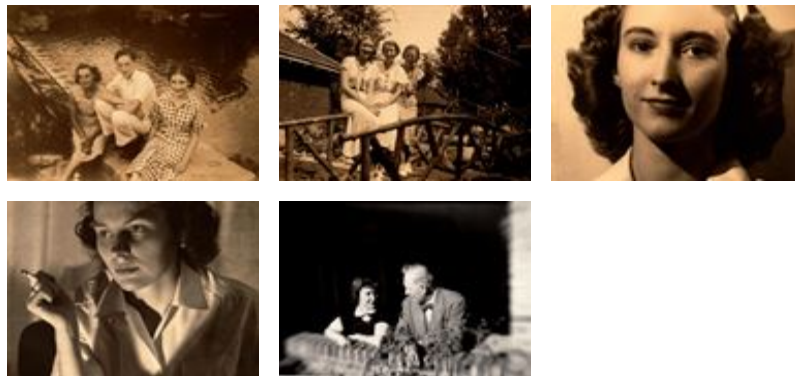
