



Charlotte Conner Bauserman McDonald

January 5, 1925 - April 13, 2009

Charlotte Conner Bauserman McDonald died on Monday, April 13, 2009 at the Londonderry Retirement Community in Easton, MD. She was 84.

Born in Ellicott City, MD on January 5, 1925 to the late Malph and Grace Conner Bauserman, Mrs. McDonald attended school in the D.C. area. She began working with the Veterans Administration as an administrative assistant. In 1944 she married Howard B. Ostmann, who preceded her in death in 1945. After moving to Mt. Rainier she met Frederick John McDonald whom she married February 23, 1957. They resided in Mt Rainer where Mrs. McDonald was a homemaker, served on the Mount Rainer City Council, belonged to the Prince George's Hospital Guild, and volunteered with the Meals on Wheels program. After Mr. McDonald's retirement in the mid 1990s, they moved to Chester, MD where Mrs. McDonald continued her volunteer work at Kent Island Elementary School. In 2005, Mrs. McDonald moved to the Londonderry Retirement Community in Easton, MD.

Mrs. McDonald is survived by 3 sons, Howard B Ostmann of League City, TX; John McDonald of Front Royal, VA, and Patrick McDonald of Queenstown, MD; daughter, Lynne Doeler of Centreville, MD; 6 grandchildren, Juli Lloyd, Rosemary Ostmann, Hannah Doeler, Jack Doeler, Patrick McDonald, and Ryan McDonald; 2 great grandchildren, Eric Lloyd and Scarlett Levinson. She is preceded in death by her husband, Frederick John McDonald.
