Cheryl Susan Hunter died suddenly at Easton Memorial Hospital on Tuesday, December 2, 2008. She was 60 years old.

Born on September 14, 1948, in Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of H. B. Gilmer and Marjorie Black Gilmer in Centreville where she attended high school. She began working with the Maryland Toll Facility, before working at Fisherman's Inn as a waitress, and, later, as a manager for 30 years. She operated her own bake shop out of her home, "Cheryl's Bake Shop," making tasty candies and cakes. While working at Fisherman's Inn, she enjoyed volunteering for Hospice of Queen Anne's.
