Chester David Affron of Camp Springs, MD passed away peacefully on December 9, 2024 in the care of Compass Regional Hospice in Centreville, MD. He was 94 years old.

He was born at home in Camp Springs on August 20, 1930, the son of the late William Affron and Ruth (Pyles) Affron. He graduated from Surrattsville High School with the class of 1947 and went on to serve his country with the United States Army shortly after. He served during the Korean War and became a Master Parachuter with the 101st Airborne. After his time in the service, he married the late Mary Allison Affron of Washington, D.C. on October 20, 1954. They had three children together. Chester worked as a lineman refueling and maintaining aircraft for National Airport for 35 years. He was a member of the Camp Springs Masonic Lodge #227. He enjoyed boating and spending time on the water, particularly on the Potomac. He was a proud veteran and loved his family dearly.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Affron; son, Michael Affron; and sisters, Ruth B. Sellner and Helen Tate.

He is survived by his daughter, Robyn Affron (Steven Rottman); son, John Affron (Kim); grandchildren: Heather (David), Rachael (Christopher), and Ryan; and great-grandchildren, Michael, Alyssa, Melanie, and Dustin.
