Chiu Hung Wong “Tony” passed away on Monday December 20th, 2021. He was 65 years old.

After leaving Hong Kong, He graduated from Queen’s University of Belfast with a Bachelor’s degree in Civil Engineering and from there moved to the United States in 1984.
