Christine Lynn DuLac, 60, of Queenstown, MD died peacefully at her home on August 29, 2025 surrounded by her husband and four children.

Christine was born in Dayton, Ohio on December 24, 1964. She was preceded in death by her parents Robert and Judith (Weiland) Cameron. Christine was a graduate of Purdue University.
