Christopher Harry Goss of Queenstown, MD died on Tuesday, April 11, 2006 at Easton Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD. He was 84.

Born April 2, 1922 in Granville, PA, he was the son of the late Charles Adam and Iva Miller Goss. On October 26, 1940 he married the former, Pearl V. Norris in Winchester, VA.
