Claire Hogan Smith died on May 20, 2011. She was 79.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, on May 5, 1932, she was the daughter of the late John and Helen Mitchell Hogan. She earned an Associate's Degree from Endicott Junior College in 1952, and went on to work for the J. Walter Thompson Advertising Agency. On July 2, 1955, she married Albert L. Smith in Tenafly, New Jersey. Mr. and Mrs. Smith traveled extensively as a result of Mr. Smith's work in the packaging business. After a tour in the United States Air Force, and prior to settling in Oxford in 1982, the couple have lived in London, England, New York, NY, New Canaan, CT, Brussels, Belgium, Winetka, IL, St. Louis, MO, Rochester, NY, Oxford, and Baltimore. Following her hobby, Claire worked part time as an antiques dealer and collector.

Mrs. Smith was a member of The Church of the Holy Trinity, the Talbot Country Club; the Ladies Auxiliary of the Oxford Fire Company, and, up until recently, the Harbor Club, the Harvard Club, and the Tred Avon Yacht Club.

She is survived by her husband, Albert L. Smith; her son, Stephen L. Smith and his wife, Kathleen B. Smith, of Coral Gables, FL; and her grandchildren, Stephanie Smith and Timothy Smith, as well as her nephew, Army Major John Hogan. She was preceded in death by her brothers, John and Edward Hogan.

Claire enjoyed being with her friends, neighbors, and family, and especially looked forward to being with her Nine Hole Ladies lunch group each week.
