May 15, 1930 - June 1, 2012

Clara Berneice Jarrell of Centreville, MD, died Friday June 1, 2012, at Corsica Hills Center in Centreville. She was 82.

Born May 15, 1930, in Denton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Walter James and Bernice Graver Candy. She was raised in Church Hill, MD, and was a graduate of Centreville High School in the Class of 1947. Following her graduation, she worked for the E.S. Adkins Lumber Co. in Centreville as a bookkeeper. In 1958, she began working at the Centreville National Bank as a bookkeeper where she held the position for 30 years, retiring in 1994.

She was a member of the Queen Anne's Quilters and has done ceramics for 20 years.
