



## Clara V. Nicholson

August 6, 1923 - June 9, 2015

Clara Nicholson of Chestertown, MD, died on June 9, 2015, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton. She was 91.

She was born on August 6, 1923, in Rock Hall, MD, to the late James and Clara Biggs Walbert. She married Harry Bates Nicholson of Chestertown in 1945. They moved to Chestertown where her husband worked as a cabinet maker and upholsterer. He predeceased her in 1987.
