Clara Taylor of Church Hill, MD died on Tuesday, March 29, 2011 at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. She was 64 years old.

Mrs. Taylor was born on February 11, 1947 in Cambridge, Maryland. She was the daughter of the late Delsworth and Agnes Crisel Bayliss. Mrs. Taylor attended Centreville High School and graduated in 1965. After high school, she worked as a secretary. In 1968, she married Charles R. Taylor. She then worked at Queen Anne's Bowling Alley and later at Leggetts Department Store. Most recently, Mrs. Taylor worked at the People's Bank for 10 years where she was a Head Teller. She was a member of the Ladies Auxiliary in Church Hill for 19 years, the Square Dance and Camping Club, and a past member of Queen Anne's Jaycees. Mrs. Taylor enjoyed collecting picture, vacations, shopping, and watching shows. She loved entertaining friends at home, crab feasts, arranging artificial flowers and scrapbooking.
