Clara Neal Schlotzhauer passed away on Sunday, January 9, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare in Easton. She was 94.

Born May 8, 1910 in Easton, she was the daughter of the late William and Annie (nee Winterbottom) Neal. Clara married Henry A. Schlotzhauer in 1931 and the couple was happily married for 29 years until Mr. Schlotzhauer's death on January 3, 1960. She worked as a homemaker for most of her adult life, raising five children in the process. She loved spending time with her children and grandchildren and in her spare time, enjoyed reading, collecting various knickknacks, and watching her favorite soap "As the World Turns."
