Baltimore, MD: On Monday, December 25, 2006 Clarence Frederick Larkins died at Corsica Hills Nursing Home surrounded by his loving family. He was 80 years old.

Clarence F. Larkins was born on April 6, 1926 in Baltimore, MD to the late Frank Larkins and Myrtle Vogel Larkins. He attended school in South Baltimore and in 1943 enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving during WWII under General Patton. In 1946 he was honorably discharged and returned home working for a local envelope company. On February 19, 1955 he married Marie Evans and resided in Baltimore. In 1957, he began working as a Baltimore City Police Officer, retiring in 1973. In 2006, he and his wife moved to Kent Island, residing with their niece, Judy.

Clarence enjoyed watching television. He was a huge fan of the Baltimore Orioles, Baltimore Colts and the Ravens.

Clarence is survived by his loving wife, Marie, of 51 years; niece, Judy Paul and her husband Donald of Stevensville, MD; and two great nephews, Donald and Steven Paul of Stevensville, MD. Survived by his brother, Francis Larkins of Stevensville, MD; sister Catherine Larkins and brother Hillary Larkins.
