



Rev. Clarence Preston Moore

May 12, 1929 - March 30, 2013

Rev. Clarence Preston Moore of Centreville, Maryland died Saturday, March 30, 2013 at Norton Healthcare Hospital in Louisville, KY. He was 83.

Born in Machipongo, Virginia on May 12, 1929. He was the son of Alonzo and Lucy Grey Moore. He graduated from Cape Charles High School in 1947. In 1952 he graduated from the University of Richmond with a B.A. in History. In 1955 he graduated from Crozer Theological Seminary with a B.D. degree. On April 28, 1956 he married Lillian Comegys of Centreville, Maryland. In 2006 they celebrated their 50th anniversary.

He pastored eight Baptist churches before retiring in 1989 after 35 years.

Rev. Moore is survived by two sons, Timothy of Louisville, Kentucky and David of Elizabeth City, North Carolina; a daughter in law, Annette; a grandson, Preston; two step grandsons Brandon and Jason; one sisters Page Jordan; a brother in law, Russ; and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his loving wife, Lillian and eight of nine sisters.
