December 31, 1940 - May 17, 2020

Clarence Marvin Wallace of Church Hill, MD, passed away Sunday, May 17, 2020, at Christiana Hospital. He was 79.

He was born December 31, 1940, in Millington, MD, the son of the late George and Mamie Wallace. He was preceded in death by his parents; former wife Ann Wallace; sister Jane Durham; and brother Carlton Wallace.

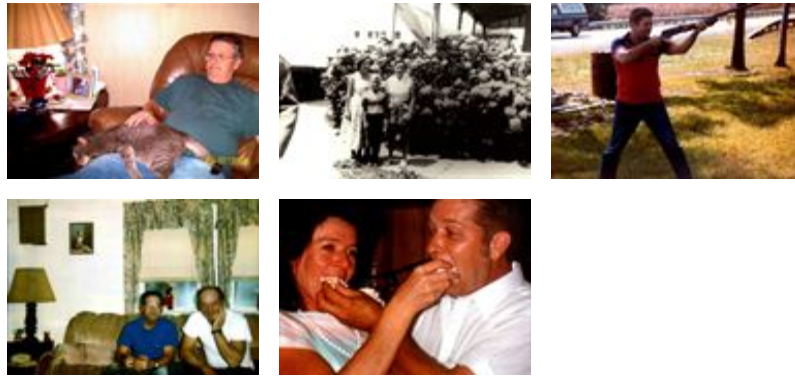

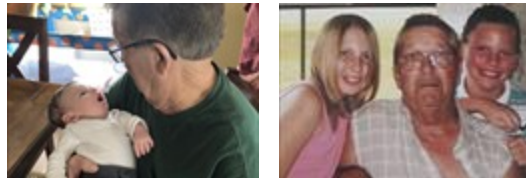
