



Clarence Paul Buckle

Suddenly on Monday, December 31, 2001, Clarence Paul Buckle of Wye Mills, MD died at the Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD of a heart attack. He was 76.

Born near Denton, MD on April 7, 1925, he was the son of the late Fred Guy and Mary Berkey Buckle. He attended school in Ridgely, MD and when he was 12 years old he started farming with his father. On January 19, 1945 he married the former Marie Blanche Schmitt of Ridgely. Mr. Buckle farmed on My Lords Gift Farm in Queenstown, MD for about 10 years and in 1965 went to work for S.E.W. Friel Co. in Queenstown, MD. He retired in 1980.

Mr. Buckle enjoyed coon hunting and raising game birds.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Buckle is survived by two daughters, Diana Mary Jewell of Grasonville, MD, Sue Saylor of Wye Mills, MD; four brothers, Fred Buckle of Goldsboro, Frank Buckle of Smyrna, DE, Geroge Buckle of Ridgely and Richard Buckle of Easton, MD; three sisters, Shirley Ross of Hurlock, MD, Doris Buckle and Ann Buckle, both of Easton, MD; two grandsons, James Reynolds of Wye Mills, MD and Danny Reynolds of Grasonville, MD and two great-grandsons, Kasey Reynolds and Buddy Reynolds, both of Wye Mills, MD.
