Clarence R. "Pop" Wolff of Centreville, MD died at the Milford-Whitinsville Regional Hospital, Milford, MA on Friday, April 2, 2004. He was 79.

Born October 16, 1924 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late John and Rose Wengert Wolff. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army Air Corps and was stationed in CA and FL where he set up radar and communication posts. Following his release from active duty he was employed as a Caterpillar Equipment repair mechanic for Alban Corporation in Maryland for nearly 30 years. He was responsible for the maintenance and repair of Alban's equipment installed in the United States Embassies throughout the world.

His wife, Mary M. Southron Wolff died September 9, 2003.
