



## Clarice L. Rosenfield

Clarice Libby Rosenfield died Sunday, January 1, 2006, at the William Hill Manor in Easton, MD, after a lengthy illness.

Born in Auburn, ME on March 3, 1928, she was the daughter of Ernest and Sarah Hyman. She is survived by her husband Aaron Rosenfield; a daughter, Sandra Rebecca Rosenfield; a sister, Shirley Sugarman of Long Island, NY; four nieces; and several grand-nieces and nephews.

After her marriage to Aaron on December 27, 1953, Clarice moved with her husband to Austin, Texas, while he completed his doctoral studies. Clarice worked in the chemistry department to support his matriculation. It was in Austin, Texas, that their daughter Sandra was born. After Aaron completed his graduate studies at the University of Texas, the family moved to Boothbay Harbor, ME, where he worked for the Fish and Wildlife Services, and Clarice became a full-time mother and homemaker. The family moved to Easton, MD, in the fall of 1962, when her husband joined the staff of the Oxford Biological Laboratory.

Clarice loved to make her family and friends happy with her cooking and baking as well as doing volunteer work. She volunteered for over 35 years at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD, in a variety of capacities including the snack bar, gift shop, the Diagnostic Center and many other activities

associated with the Ladies Auxiliary. She was a member of the congregation Temple B’Nai Israel in Easton. She served a term as the Sisterhoods President and was particularly active in fundraising for the Children’s Education.

Burial services will be private. Memorial services are being arranged for at a later date. The family will be home at 633 Howard Street from 1 – 4 p.m. Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, January 4, 5, and 6th to receive visitors.
