September 28, 1925 - January 28, 2011

Clarice Horney Knapp of Grasonville, MD died Friday, January 28, 2011 at Corsica Hill Nursing Home in Centreville. She was 85.

Born in Grasonville, MD on September 28, 1925, she was the daughter of Clarence Albert and Maggie May Horney. She graduated from Stevensville High School, Class of 1942 and then attended Washington Missionary College in Takoma Park, MD. She started her career as a hospital technician at Leland Memorial Hospital in Riverdale, MD. Mrs. Knapp married Richard E. Knapp of Middletown, NY in 1946, and moved to Middletown. In 1952, she returned to Grasonville, MD and began raising her family. Mrs. Knapp worked for Perfect Garment in Grasonville and then went to work for Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. She retired in 1987 after 25 years of service as a technician.

Mrs. Knapp was a member of Grasonville Seventh Day Adventist Church. She worked at the Grasonville Adventist Community Service Building once a week.
