



## Claudia Cronshaw

October 21, 1915 - March 30, 2008

Claudia Josephine (Meeks) Cronshaw of Chestertown, Maryland died on March 30, 2008 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. She was 92.

She was born near Hillsboro, Maryland in Caroline County on October 21, 1915 the daughter of the late Thomas Hayward and Margaret Estelle Robinson Meeks. She attended Cedar Grove, a one room school house, and graduated from Caroline High School in Denton, Maryland. She worked for Park Cleaners in Chestertown in the 1950's and at Leeds Travel Ware in the 1960's and 1970's. She retired in 1974.

She married Kennard Wallace Cronshaw, the son of the late James Henry and Rosalee Morris Cronshaw of Price, Maryland.

Mrs. Cronshaw attended and actively supported Kent Senior Center for nearly Twenty years, serving as chairperson for several years. She served as treasurer of AARP chapter 3635 of Kent County, MD and was on the Advisory Council for Upper Shore Aging, Inc. for four years. Ceramics and Arts and Crafts were her pastime. Her family was her pride and joy.

Mrs. Cronshaw was a member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church of Denton, MD.
