Claudia Bridges, formerly from Easton, went home to be with the Lord on July 6, 2010. She was 83.

Claudia grew up in McDaniel and the St. Michaels area. She was the daughter of Anna Harrison Sewell and Claude F. Sewell. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1944, she worked in Washington, D.C. as a secretary. She married James L. Bridges in 1944. He preceded her in death in 2008. A brother, Maurice Sewell, also preceded her in death.
