Clayton O. Barnett of Queenstown, MD died February 7, 2008 at his home surrounded by his family and friends. He was 52.

Born on December 6, 1955 in Crowley, LA, he was the son of Alpha Barnett and the late, Hazel Lutz Barnett. Clay grew up in Seguin, TX and was a graduate of Seguin High School class of 1975. After high school he began working as an office manager in the construction industry. In 1988 he moved to Columbia, MD and worked as an office manager for Cherry Hill Construction in Laurel, MD. During his employment with Cherry Hill Construction Clay attended University of Phoenix where he obtained his education in technology. Mr. Barnett then became Cherry Hill Construction's IT manager. He later moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in Easton and presently to Queenstown, MD. In 2004 he co-established and operated Centreville Shipping and Services. Clay enjoyed computers, spending time at the beach and will always be remembered for being a jack of all trades as he always was willing to offer a helping hand to anyone who needed help.
