



Clifford Hilk

November 14, 1937 - March 28, 2012

Clifford L. Hilk passed away peacefully surrounded by family and friends on March 28, 2012, at William Hill Manor in Easton. Mr. Hilk was born November 14, 1937, in Pittsburgh, PA, the son of the late Vincent Kenneth Hilk and Dorothy Schubert Hilk.

Mr. Hilk was a 1955 graduate of Sharon High School. He served in the United States Army as a cryptographer from 1956 to 1958. He was a graduate of the American Institute of Banking and the University of Wisconsin, School of Banking.

Mr. Hilk was employed in the banking industry for 45 years to include 28 years in Pennsylvania and 17 years at St. Michaels Bank, retiring in June 2003 as Senior Vice President. He also taught banking for 10 years.

Mr. Hilk was a former commissioner and past chairman of Easton Utilities, serving from 1993 to 2005. He also served on the Easton Housing Authority from 1992 through 2003 and was Chairman since 1996. He served as Treasurer of the Harold Baines Golf Tournament for sixteen years, since its inception in 1991. Mr. Hilk was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church for 25 years and served as Treasurer from 2008 to 2011. At the time of his death, he was a trustee of the church. He was a member and past treasurer to the Easton Lions Club, member of Talbot County Chamber of Commerce, and

also Talbot Country Club. Prior to moving to Easton, Mr. Hilk was a former member of Covenant Presbyterian Church, Sharon Kiwanis, and Sharon Country Club.

He is survived by his daughter, Cheryl of Sharpsville, PA; son, Dan and wife Colleen of Irwin, PA; and brother, Gerald and his wife Julie of Cincinnati, OH; three grandchildren, Kelly, Arianna and Evan; and several nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his loving wife of 48 years, Joan, whom he married on May 24, 1958.

Services will be held at 11a.m., Monday, April 2, at Immanuel Lutheran Church, 7215 Ocean Gateway Easton.
