Clyde Oney of Chestertown, Maryland died Friday September 8 at home. He was 84.

Mr. Oney was born in Mt. Sterling, Kentucky on February 22, 1923 to the late William Patton and Nannie Gullet Oney. He joined the U.S. Navy at the age of 17. Mr. Oney served on the battleship U.S.S. Maryland and was at Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941. He served on several ships and was with the fleet at Japan at the end of World War II. After serving his country, Mr. Oney went to work for Bethlehem Steel in Baltimore, where he worked for thirty years. In 1965, he bought a farm in Centreville and sold it in 1997 when he and his wife moved to Chestertown. Mr. Oney was a member of the Jephthah Masonic Lodge #222 in Essex and the VFW Lodge #652 in Millington. He loved farming and raising Black Angus cattle.

In addition to his wife, Alvira Nettie Oney of 60 years, he is survived by one son, Steven Oney of Baltimore, Maryland. He was predeceased by three brothers: Willard Oney, Millard Oney, and Bert Oney and two sisters: Sarah Oney Brown and Lake Oney.
