



Clyde Earl Wynne

August 31, 1925 - August 20, 2018

Clyde Earl Wynne of Chester, MD, passed away on August 20, 2018, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 92.

Born on August 31, 1925, in Eastport, MD, to the late Clyde Wynne and Catherine Wheeler Wynne, He enlisted in the US Navy in 1942, serving during World War II, and was honorably discharged in 1946. On September 19, 1949, he married Dorothy B. Wynne, and they made their home in Severn, MD. Mr. Wynne spent his career with the Army Air Force Exchange Service until 1974, when he began to sell real estate. He moved to Chester in 1975 and would continue to sell real estate, retiring six months before his wife died.

Mr. Wynne was a loving husband and good father. He was a past member of the Kent Island Yacht Club, VFW, Elks Lodge, Moose Lodge, American Legion, Knights of Columbus and belonged to St. Christopher's Catholic Church.

He is survived by two sons, John Michael Wynne of Denton, MD, and Timothy Robert Wynne of Stockton, MD; and four grandchildren, Phillip, Jessica, Madison and Richie Wynne. In addition to his wife, his brother, John W. Wynne, and sister, Mildred Jean Naff, predeceases him.
