



Colleen Harrison Sewell

June 10, 1938 - April 25, 2017

Colleen Harrison Sewell of Easton, MD, died on Tuesday, April 25, 2017, at her home. She was 78.

Born on June 10, 1938, in Tilghman, MD, she was the daughter of the late Page and Virginia Murphy Harrison. After her graduation from high school, she worked at the Pentagon. She was married on March 9, 1957, to Jimmy Sewell, who predeceased her in 2003. They made their home in Easton, where she raised her family and worked with the Talbot County Election Board, retiring as Election Director in 2001.

Mrs. Sewell was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton. She volunteered at St. Marks Thrift Store for many years. She enjoyed playing cards with friends, reading, and doing crossword puzzles.

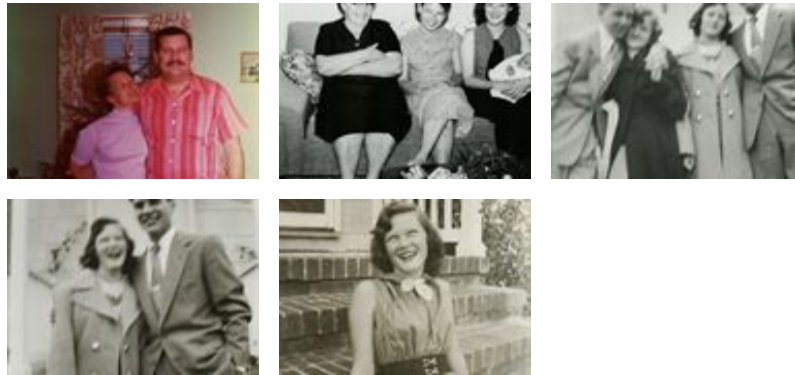
